- May chip or crack from impacts
- Requires maintenance painting

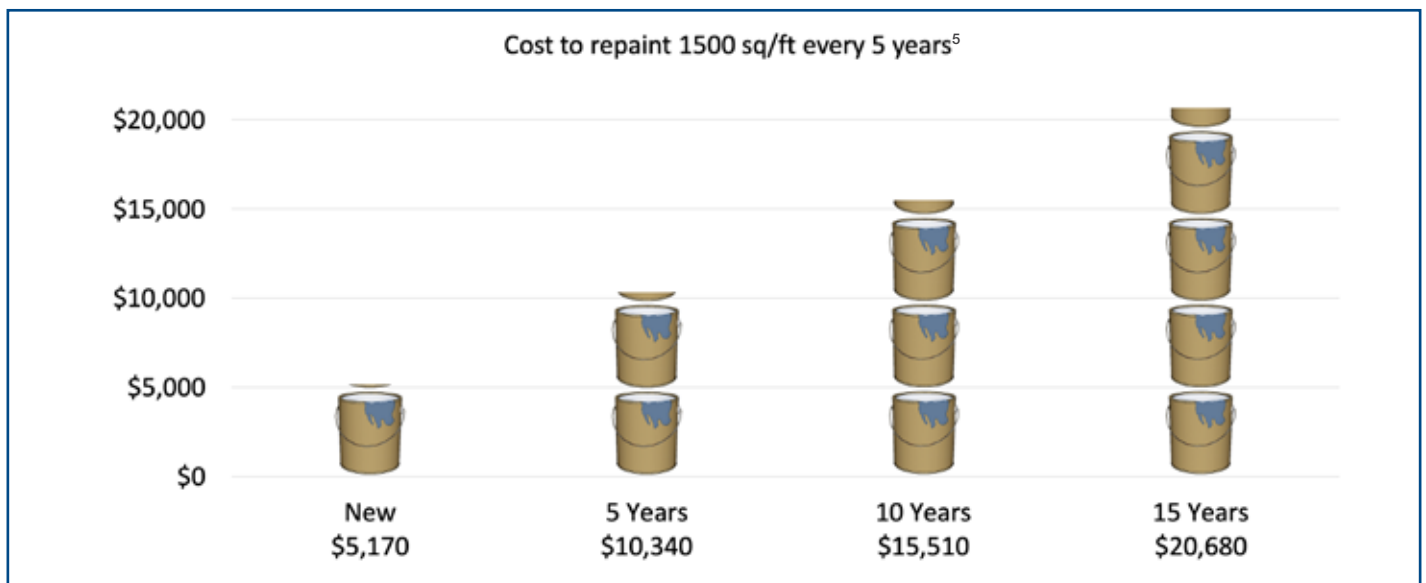
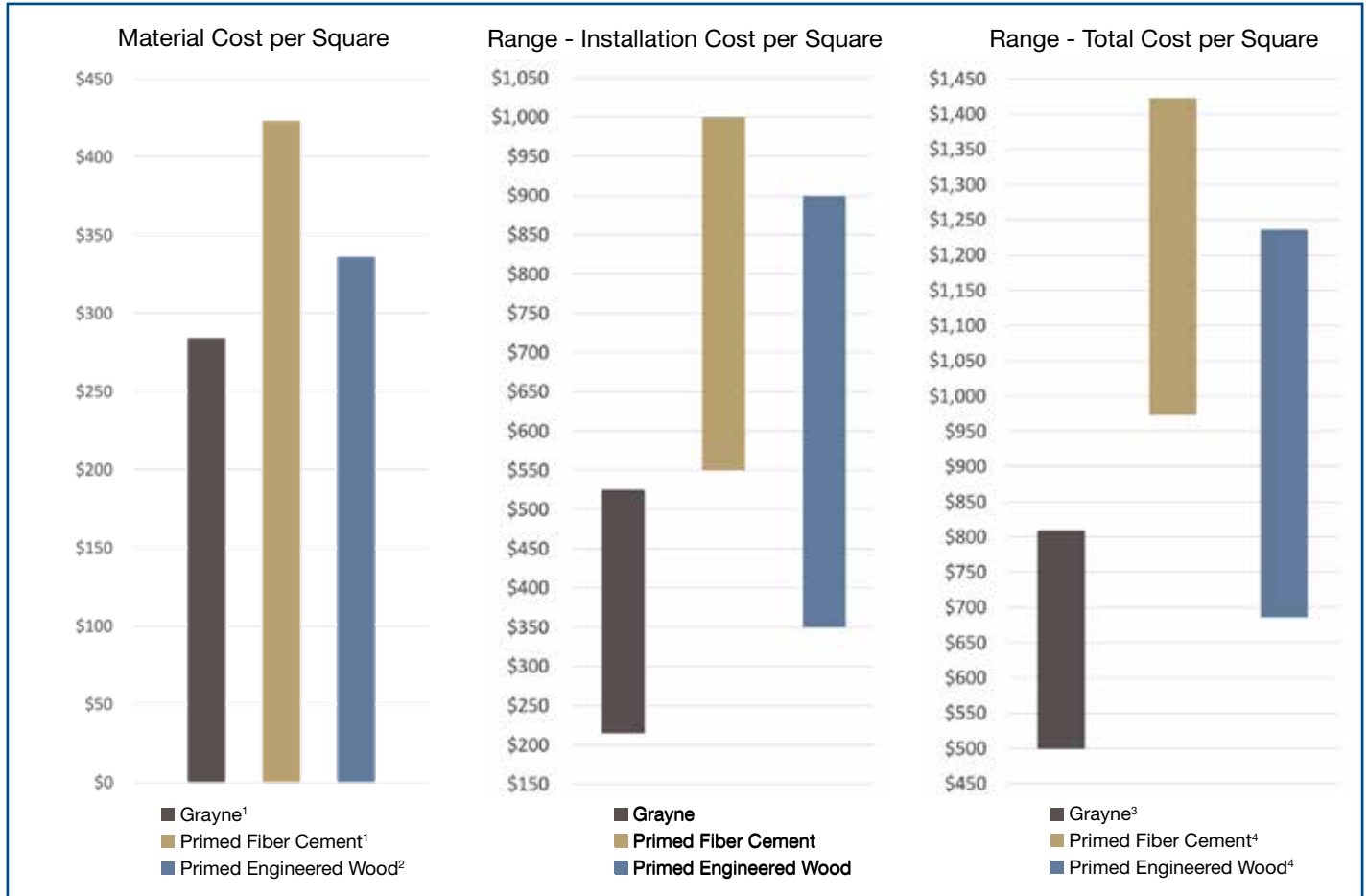


Engineered Wood

- Needs extra time to seal end cuts
- Face nailing hurts curb appeal
- Must caulk nails that penetrate the surface
- Requires maintenance painting
- Class C fire rating
